Detectives with the Crash Reconstruction Unit are investigating a fatal pedestrian-involved crash that occurred at the intersection of North Shore Drive at Village Road, in Reston. The crash occurred on Sunday, August 28, at approximately 5:19 p.m. It is believed a yellow Ford Escape may have struck the pedestrian. The vehicle and its driver failed to stop. The vehicle may have front end damage on the driver's side.

You are encouraged to contact police if:

- You recognize this vehicle
- You have seen this driver and/or vehicle in your neighborhood
- You have any information regarding this incident

Remember, the information you have, regardless of how trivial you feel it may be, could be the critical link in solving this case.
